

ORDINANCE NO. OR06-03

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BRILLION**

The Common Council of the City of Brillion do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: The following described real estate, owned by Robert Endries, located in the City of Brillion, Calumet County, Wisconsin, which is presently zoned I-2 – (Heavy Industrial District) be rezoned as C-2 (Commercial District-Highway). The property is described as follows:

Commencing at the South ¼ corner of said Section 23; thence North 89 degrees 29 minutes 54 seconds West, along the south line of said Southwest ¼, a distance of 780.72 feet; thence North 00 degree 30 minutes 06 seconds East, 4.88 feet to the point of beginning; thence 537.87 feet along an arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 1909.86 feet with a chord which bears North 77 degrees 50 minutes 01 seconds West, along the centerline of USH 10 (W. Ryan Street), 536.10 feet; thence North 00 degree 20 minutes 40 seconds East, along the wet line of said Lot 4 of Certified Survey Map No. 2812, a distance of 142.83 feet; thence South 89 degree 22 minutes 02 second East, 525.94 feet; thence South 00 degree 37 minutes 58 seconds West, along the east line of said Lot 4 also beginning the west line of Northway Drive, 250.00 to the point of beginning, containing 108,445 square feet (2.490 Acres).

SECTION II: That the district boundaries as shown on the zoning map pursuant to the Municipal Code of Ordinance of the City of Brillion are hereby changed to comply with the said above described zoning amendment.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in accordance with law.

Ordinance No. OR06-03 introduced and its adoption by Alderperson Edinger; and Seconded by Alderperson Fischer.
