

ORDINANCE NO. OR06-04

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WARD DESIGNATION
FOR ANNEXED TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF
BRILLION, WISCONSIN**

The Common Council of the City of Brillion, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with sec. 66.0217(2) and sec. 66.0217(8) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the following described territory was annexed to the City of Brillion, Wisconsin affective July 28, 2004:

The real property subject to this petition is that part of the Northwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 36, Township 20 North, Range 20 East, Town of Brillion, Calumet County, Wisconsin containing 996,565 Square Feet (22.878 Acres) of land and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the North ¼ corner of said Section 36; Thence N89°27'43"E, 872.62 feet along the North line of the Northeast ¼ of said Section 36; Thence S00°39'26"E, 1024.75 feet to the Northerly right-of-way line of East Hills Road; Thence N87°33'46"W, 166.02 feet along said Northerly right-of-way line to the start of a 249.87 foot radius curve to the left; Thence 276.61 feet along the arc of said curve to the left having a chord which bears S60°44'57"W, 262.70 feet to the start of a 190.07 foot radius curve to the right; Thence 211.31 feet along the arc of said curve to the right having a chord which bears S59°36'53"W, 200.59 feet; Thence N88°32'26"W, 302.20 feet along said Northerly right-of-way line to the West line of the Northeast ¼ of said Section 36; Thence N00°39'26"W, 1231.63 feet along said West line to the Point of Beginning.

(This property is located at the southeast corner of Round Lake Road and National Avenue)

SECTION 2. Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1, which was originally designated as part of Ward 2 at the time of annexation, is hereby made a part of the Ward 5 of the City of Brillion, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Brillion governing wards.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
