

ORDINANCE NO. OR06-14

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE
CHAPTER 94, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES,
ARTICLE III., TRAFFIC SCHEDULES,
DIVISION 6., PARKING, SUBDIVISION IV., TWO-HOUR PARKING
SECTION 94-266, PARKING TIME LIMITATIONS,
IN THE CITY OF BRILLION, CALUMET COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Common Council of the City of Brillion do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 94, Traffic and Vehicles, Article III., Traffic Schedules, Division 6., Parking, Subdivision IV., Two-Hour Parking, Sec. 94-266., Parking Time Limitations, are hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

Sec. 94-266. Parking time limitations.

When signs are erected in any block giving notice, no person shall park any vehicle on any of the following streets or alleys or parts of such streets or alleys for longer than two hours between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Fridays and from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on any other day except Sundays and holidays:

- (1) Westernmost row of parking spaces of the City Hall, 130 Calumet Street, west public parking lot.
- (2) North side of Calumet Street with its intersection with Main Street east to the fire department driveway.
- (3) West side of Main Street commencing with a point on the north side of Park Avenue; across Main Street and south to a point 174.5 feet south of West Water Street directly in front of the light standard in front of the municipal pump station.
- (4) East side of Main Street from the south curb on Park Avenue south along the east side of Main Street to a point 174.5 feet south of West Water Street or directly across from the light standard in front of the pump station.
- (5) South side of Calumet Street from its intersection with Main Street east a distance of 106 feet.
- (6) North and South Main Streets between Park Avenue and West Water Street.
- (7) Directly in front of the city hall property on the north side of Calumet Street.
- (8) East side of North Francis Street from Park Avenue to a point 150 feet south.

- (9) North side of Oak Street between Main Street and Francis Street. ,Except for residents and tenants having an Oak St. address. Visitors must first receive permission from the police department. Residents and tenants do not require permission to park adjacent to their residence as long as the vehicle involved is currently registered to the person residing at that address with the proper address listed on DOT registration and the vehicle is operable.

Any guest or other family member with registration listing to any other address must first contact the Brillion Police Department and receive permission to park a vehicle on Oak St. prior to such parking.

- (10) North side of Park Street between Main Street and Francis Street.
- (11) North side of Schley Street from its intersection with North Main Street west a distance of 150 feet.
- (12) Either side of Jackson Street, from Main Street to Custer Street, between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on any day, Monday through Friday, except holidays.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.

Ordinance Number OR06-14 introduced and its adoption moved by Alderperson Bastian; and seconded by Alderperson Bonick.
