WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

**Common Questions we are asked :**

Q - Can my child under the age of 16 years old operate an ATV on city streets?

A - Any rider must have a valid driver's license to operate on public streets.

Q - Can I cross Main St. on an angle where the streets do not line up?

A - The intent of the ordinance is to allow you to access a connecting trail and local businesses. If you operate lengthwise on prohibited streets, you can be cited for operating on a highway.

Q - Can I drive to work by driving through a City Park?

A - No, operation is not allowed on any unpaved City property, which includes parks and cemeteries.

Q - Do I need to register an ATV before I can ride it on the street?

A - Yes, you must have State registration stickers displayed as well as a City permit before riding. (Contact the police department or City Clerk for an application for a trail use sticker. All information relevant to operating ATV's on City streets is in the application packet.

# CITY ATV ROUTE

## 1. The operation of ATV's will be allowed under the following conditions:

To operate in a safe manner to reach a connecting trail or to your home or a local business within the city limits of Brillion only.

## 2. Operation of ATV's is prohibited in the following areas:

- A. U.S. Hwy-10 / East & West Ryan St.. lengthwise, on its entirety. (You may cross Hy-10 in a safe, legal manner)
- B. On any sidewalk in the city.
- C. Within the boundaries of any city park or cemetery. Unless you remain on paved areas designated for automobile travel only.
- D. Upon any private property, without previously expressed written permission by the owner.

## 3. Slow moving vehicle sign

The operator of ATV's shall display a slow moving vehicle sign on the rear of such vehicle if the unit is not able to maintain a speed of 25 MPH. That does not mean that the unit must be operated at 25 MPH., just that it is capable of maintaining that speed.

## 4. Equipment Restrictions:

No ATV operating in the city shall be allowed if it has any modifications or defects to original equipment other than the replacement of original manufacturer's parts.

**ATV mufflers must be original equipment without modifications**

## 5. Lights Required:

No ATV may be operated within city limits unless it displays a lighted headlight and tail light at all times, day or night. All lights must conform to the requirements of section 350.09 of Wisconsin statutes and be visible at a distance of 200 feet.

## 6. Position on Roadway:

ATV's shall only be operated on the right most side of the roadway, as close to the edge of the roadway as physically possible and in the same direction as regular vehicular traffic on the same roadway.

**PROOF OF INSURANCE  
REQUIRED  
ON ALL ATVS BEFORE PERMIT  
WILL BE ISSUED**

**\* EXEMPTION**– An ATV may be operated onto the traveled portion of the roadway **only** when an obstacle is encountered, such as a bridge or parked motor vehicle. The operator of the ATV **must immediately** return to the far right edge of the roadway upon passing such obstacle. Unless such ATV can maintain the posted speed limit of that section of street.

## **ALL OTHER LAWS APPLY**

---

Any operator of an ATV will be responsible for any and all other traffic laws, City ordinances and rules and regulations that apply within the City limits of Brillion, including but not limited to: traffic signs signals & markings, noise ordinances, vehicle registration and equipment etc.
