

ORDINANCE NO. OR07-09

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BRILLION**

The Common Council of the City of Brillion do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: The following described real estate, owned by the City of Brillion, located in the City of Brillion, Calumet County, Wisconsin, which is presently zoned R-2 – (Two-Family Residential District) be rezoned as C-1 (Downtown Commercial District). The property is described as follows:

Part of Lots Four (4) and Three (3), Block One (1), Daskam and Jones' Addition, City of Brillion, Calumet County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 4, Block 1 of said Daskam and Jones' Addition, thence running North Seventy (70) feet, thence East to property of Chicago & Northwestern Railroad Co., thence Southeasterly along said property of Chicago & Northwestern Railroad Co. to its intersection with the South line of said Lot 4 Block 1, Daskam and Jones' Addition, thence West to the point of beginning.

Tax Parcel No. 206-0046-010040A-000-0-202026-00-1400

Lot Five (5), Block One (1) Daskam and Jones' Addition, City of Brillion, Calumet County, Wisconsin. EXCEPT that parcel commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 5, Block 1 is said Daskam and Jones' Addition, running thence West Twenty-eight (28) feet, thence in the Southeasterly direction to a point 16 ½ feet West of the Southeast corner of said Lot 5, thence East 16 ½ feet and thence North to the place of beginning.

SECTION II: That the district boundaries as shown on the zoning map pursuant to the Municipal Code of Ordinance of the City of Brillion are hereby changed to comply with the said above described zoning amendment.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in accordance with law.
