Summer Reading

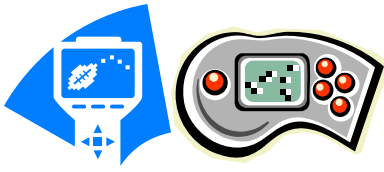
