CALL TO ORDER: Al Ebert called the meeting to order at 4:01PM.

ROLL CALL: Present were: Al Ebert, Mark Rajkovich, Joe Behnke, Sarah Pielhop, Dennis Miller, Dawn Dietrich and Alderperson Vicki Shafran. Also present was Recreation Director/Aquatic Coordinator Ann Marx.

DIRECTOR REPORTS:

A. Parks:

Pielhop requested a special meeting to discuss just parks. She asked the Commission what their vision of each park is. She stated that the Jaycee's are looking to doing some fund raisers for Heritage Park and the Optimist are looking at Horn Park. The fund raising would take place at the respective parks.

The band shelter at Horn was discussed. The roof is in good shape and could possibly be used for music in the park.

The Optimist is looking at adding handicap playground equipment to Horn Park but that would lead to the need for handicap bathrooms. Getting water to different areas of Horn for new bathrooms and a possible new shelter someday would be at the cities expense.

The Optimist is recommending that trees in Horn Park be taken down to start the handicap playground project.

Shafran stated that right now the Commission does have a lot to focus on with the BCC updates and the new ball diamond at Peters. Rajkovich agreed. Shafran also had a concern with vandalism at Horn Park.

The recent water issue at Peters was discussed in regards to the new field.

Motion - Pielhop moved to see if we need an engineer for the water drainage at Peters and if so have McMann look at it. Seconded by Ebert. Motion approved.

Discussion followed regarding the use of weed killer.

Motion - Miller moved that no roundup or vegetation killer can be sprayed in any city park or BCC property without permission from the Park and Rec board. Seconded by Rajkovich. Motion approved.

At the end of the meeting it was decided to focus on the BCC updates, the water problem at Peters so the construction of the new field can start. If it doesn't start this fall we could possibly lose some funding and to have tree's removed from Horn.
